ARTICLE ONE - Multiverse Overseer Council

Overview:

MOC is an acronym, meaning "Multiverse Overseer Council."

The MOC is an organization focused primarily on the maintenance of stability throughout all Universes and all spaces within the confines of Reality. The MOC's employee count shifts often, ranging generally between three to seven thousand employees.

The MOC's namesake, occasionally referred to as "High Council" internally to avoid confusion, is the head that makes all executive decisions. At the time of this document's writing, there are six active members, who confer on decisions that cannot be solved by a single member alone.

The Council:

The MOC's six active members are usually stationed in locations that have the most instability or other activity of interest, in order to allow for quick responses to sudden incident cases. At the time of this document's writing, there are five members active in Division 4, and one stationed in Division 10.

All but one member of the Council is an Eighth Density entity. As Eighth Density, each member exists as a conglomerate of their repeating iterations between different Universes, whether in one Division or all. Each of them is theoretically immortal, requiring a total lack of existence in every Universe.

Our Seventh Density Council member has shown to be one of the most capable and useful D7s in MOC employment, but also one of the most vulnerable, as her death would be permanent. The probability of this is unlikely, as all conceptual entities are particularly resilient to physical damage, as harming their bodies is harming their vessel.

The council is fairly homogenous in its decisions and has yet to see any major conflict within the meeting halls. However, the MOC has also yet to see any major conflict more dire than events such as the Sector-02 Cascade, and it is unknown how the High Council will fare under stress.

Below is a list of the current active council members, their current duties within the MOC, and small lists of some of their different aliases.

MOC25-AUT The embodiment of Authorship. Does not head any subunits. Her duties consist mostly of writing reports for the MOC and recording data. Wonderful proofreader, the best editor. Should most likely be placed on more incident cases. All information listed here is true. In reality, planning to found the Reporter's Subunit, to help split up the Timekeeper's Ward. Aliases include:

Objectives:

As stated, the MOC's primary goal is the maintenance, safety, and caretaking of all things within the space defined as Reality. All universes, their contents, and the denizens with them are listed as things that must be protected. This goal is very broad and incredibly hard to carry out without further preparation, even with the council being made up of entities ranging from Fourth to Eighth Density. Despite the abilities and strengths of each employee and Council member, it is nigh impossible to truly protect all Universes.

Due to this, the MOC works towards secondary goals that direct back towards the primary. These include objectives such as improving the quality of life within all ascended universes, discovering more effective ways of maintaining high stability, capture and potential removal of insurgent entities, ensuring only a natural progression of life throughout histories, research on the nature of the UMs, and theories on the potential for an RM.

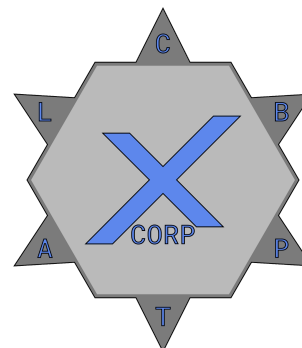
Partnerships:

Occasionally, business partnerships between the MOC and other multiversal organizations have been established, to the benefit of both parties and the rest of Reality. In the past, the MOC has partnered with only two large organizations, due to a distinct lack of other organizations that exist. In all cases, the other organizations reached out first as they believed they knew how to support the MOC. These two other organizations are the Paulina Lotte Company and X-Corp. Both companies have offered their support in reaching the goals set by the MOC.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, the Paulina Lotte Company, the first organization to partner with the MOC, disappeared along with all machinery, research, and blueprints held by them at the time. The only remaining artifacts of their existence were devices scattered around Reality, devices given to the MOC, and other properties offered before their disappearance.

X-Corp is currently the only partner of the MOC, as of the writing of this document. The relationship has been quiet, but words have occasionally been shared between the two organizations. This is due in part to the fact that X-Corp has not yet progressed to the level of the MOC's technology, the same way that the MOC still has yet to reach the same level as the Lotte Company. The MOC refuses to share technology with this organization, as this would interfere with the goal of allowing life to progress naturally with as little outside help as possible.

Notable Subunits:

Visionary Bureau

- A subunit consisting of many employees who work with art, modeling, woodworkers, and other creative categories. Currently managed by the Director of the Visionary Bureau, Aesphema, also serving as MOC02-AES. Other categories include architects, civil engineering, film, photography, and web development. This is one of the broadest subunits and possibly less focused on the primary objectives than any other. Organizations need appealing design once they reach a certain size.

Judicial Committee

- A subunit focused on the dealings of rules, edicts, and punishments to the employees of the MOC or its child organizations. Operated by the High Judge, known otherwise as MOC12-LAW. Punishments can range from verbal reprimands to time spent in rehabilitation centers outside of main MOC offices. This subunit also serves as law enforcement for itself, with some employees working as security officers that report directly to their superiors. This subunit is therefore also responsible for surveillance. Currently managing "The Sphere," a containment unit designed for the entity at the top of the list of "POI-VN Instances."

Timekeeper's Ward

- The subunit that manages, in essence, time itself. Most employees sent out to resolve causal incidents, time loops, most often, are from this subunit. Consists of concepts and physical entities that have some grasp on the flow of time and potentially some control over it. Head by Causality herself, also serving as MOC13-CAU. The Timeline is also managed by this subunit, categorizing all significant events within Reality in chronological order, in multiple forms between accelerated and objective time. Many MOC reporters also work here, cataloging the information they receive and uploading it to IA systems.

The Comedy Show

- A fairly small subunit of the MOC that runs an annual stand-up comedy in a random Division's central MOCmHQ. Run by MOC22-COM, who has won every single showing to date. Employees of this subunit manage the setup and cleanup of the show, but also occasionally get priority pickings during the show. Otherwise, you need not even be an employee to watch or even take part.

Internal Affairs

- A subunit headed by MOC12-LAW, which manages all data and other digital implements of the MOC. Responsible for setting up the software, the systems, and making them accessible for employees in all other subunits. Also responsible for *protecting* this data from outside attacks, creating encryption, defending and hiding data servers, and obfuscating information. Distributes information as necessary. Investigators for deeper analysis of incidents or the entities who cause them are also employed by this subunit.

Edict B-06:

This Edict proposes that the MOC and all other Multiversal organizations have a responsibility to both protect Universes from outside threats, but to also not interfere with the learning process or evolution of all life within them. This is one particular Edict that the MOC takes very seriously, and is one of the foundational ideals of the organization.

Edict B-07:

Data on this Edict has been excised from this document.

ARTICLE TWO - Paulina Lotte Company

Overview:

The Paulina Lotte Company was an engineering organization. They had invented a myriad of products that were of mild interest due to their abilities or details, and other times of direct use to the goals of the MOC. In some cases, these devices were even able to manipulate the laws of physics within the entire span of a UM. It is currently unknown as of this document's writing whether the Lotte Company ever took the next step into manipulating a potential RM themselves.

The company's namesake was based on the CEO and founder of the company, Paulina Lotte, formerly an engineer and inventor responsible for her Universe's ascension to the multiverse. Most everyone employed by them worked on creating new machinery using tools and devices previously invented by the company, making it a sort of inventor's convention.

CEO Paulina Lotte:

Paulina Lotte was an inventor and engineer at the top of her class. She was responsible for the creation of most devices on the list of revolutionary inventions, including the Paulina Lotte Device, the Timewarper Series, and the Stabilifier Series.

Most any entity that existed during the time of the Lotte Company was familiar with the company and its CEO. Many entities knew Lotte personally and contributed their ideas to the organization despite not working for them.

She was very open to both criticism and support from her peers and consumers. It was viewed as a universal tragedy when it was learned that her entire organization had disappeared along with her. Not only was a valuable company and all of its knowledge destroyed, but so was a widely respected person and an entire culture of people and employees. This document is no memoir, but Lotte was arguably one of the most important people to exist.

Lotte was a sixth-density entity, a biological human with no conceptual body to work with. Due to this, she was incredibly vulnerable, as were most of her employees. This may or may not be related to her disappearance. Despite the limitations of her humanity, Lotte developed a form of immortality resistant to both aging and forms of attack. Most employees also used this same form of eternal life.

Lotte's Home:

The colloquial name given to Lotte's home Universe. It is unknown where this is located, as it is one of the things that was kept secret throughout the lifespan of the organization, and figuring out this information is now theoretically impossible due to the disappearance of many other Lotte structures and knowledge that would be necessary to locate an isolated Universe throughout the entire span of Reality.

It is known that she was the first person to escape her Universe, and it is possible that she is the first nonconceptual human being to ever manipulate and escape the Universal Membrane surrounding their Universe. It is estimated that this Universe is a C-Series, due to it being possible for a nonconceptual entity to escape. It is also unknown how Lotte and her employees managed to survive in FSCO space, but this could involve an unlisted device that drags a bubble of Universe around the user.

Lotte Disappearance Event:

Estimated to have occurred during the year 6.7e612. The event took nearly two years, a small amount of time relative to most other events throughout Reality. Over this span of time, communications between the Lotte company and the MOC ground to a halt as different buildings owned by the company disappeared, along with their employees and even Lotte herself.

All items within the buildings were removed as well, leaving nothing left to trace back to the reason as to why they disappeared. The fate of Lotte, her company, and its employees are unknown as of the writing of this document.

It is unknown as to what caused the event, either. Some theories exist connecting the event to the vague listings about new products, but it is unsure if these products are related at all, if they were the direct cause, or taught something that led to a disaster.

As it stands, it is impossible to know what happened to the Lotte company or why. Investigations are still regularly sent out to search for distant Lotte locations and to search for more information regarding the disappearance event.

Product Listing:

[Note that these products have been slightly translated from a different alphabet, and consistency is not guaranteed.]

Timewarper Mk.I

- "Developed in the year UY9.3e613, the Timewarper Mk.1 was created last in the line of Timewarper products. The intention of its inventions was simply to close the loop of the Timewarper products in order to make its existence possible. It is not available for public use."
- As stated, this is the final product in the Timerwarper series of products. Development of this product relative to the passage of time, the line follows TW-Mk3, TW-Mk2, and TW-Mk1. In order of the development relative to which was designed "first," the line follows TW-Mk2, TW-Mk3, and TW-Mk1.

Timewarper Mk.III

- "Developed 37 years before Mk.II, the TW-Mk3 shows off its ability through its creation alone! When used properly, it can be used to traverse countless times and places just by using the user-friendly, patented timewarp interface! We are not responsible for any broken causality caused by use."
- The TW-Mk3s are often used by the MOC's employees who do not have control over the passage of time for quick & easy resolution of smaller-scale time loops, especially when MOC13-CAU is unavailable or otherwise unwilling to resolve minor loops.

Timewarper Mk.II

- This product was not listed on the Lotte product listing page, so the details of it are unknown, but it was the first Timewarper product to be designed by the Lotte company and therefore gains an entry in this list.

Ukebase

- "It's a bass that sounds exactly like a ukulele! We don't know why we made it, but it's available for the public to use at a low price. Warranty void upon physical contact."

Baseuke

- "It's a ukulele that sounds exactly like a bass! We don't know why we made it, but it's available for the public to use at a low price. Warranty void upon physical contact."

Nekonomicon

- "Not a product that we sell, but an object that customers are allowed to borrow for a short period of time. You should make sure to have bought our other products! This is a valuable book, we'd like to keep our hands on it. It's only for trusted customers."
- The MOC is unsure what this book is supposed to be. The product disappeared from their listing before any employees were able to borrow the book.

Stabilifier I

- "The Stabilifier Mk.I, designed by the CEO's secretary, is supposedly capable of increasing the stability of an entire Universe just by fiddling with the dial on the right side properly! Testing is still in progress."
- This product increases a universe's overall stability at the cost of slowly removing the region around the device from existence. However, this is a very unexpected response on the part of the universe, as the stability appears to be drawn from nowhere in particular, and all energy and matter within the removed space disappears without any traces whatsoever and most likely from Reality itself.

Stabilifier II

- "The first version of the product actually *decreased* local universal stability, but after recalls, modifications, repairs, and coverups, we have finalized the Stabilifier and now you can use it too! Local universal stability will increase in moments after use!"
- An interesting aspect of this product is that it does not increase stability throughout the universe, but rather by drawing more universe towards the area around the device, increasing stability locally, but overall decreasing it by distributing space unevenly. It has seen sparse use in desperate situations involving universes already in collapse when the destruction is imminent but there are certain things that have yet to be removed. Essentially, the last resort option. This appears to be the inverse of the Stabilifier Mk.I.

Lumina Transporter Engine

- "This simple device is the Alcubierre drive of the future! By manipulating isolated pieces of UM, we can warp Reality around whatever we please! Requiring much less energy and running much more precisely, the Lotte company has revolutionized the transportation industry between Universes!"
- The Lumina Engines were indeed revolutionary and helped the MOC make the Divisions much more interconnected than ever before. Despite the MOC having already developed immediate communication between any distances through quantum entanglement relays, the Lumina Engine has made it not only easier to travel between Divisions, but has made it practical as well. These engines are, so far, only operated by the MOC in personal vehicles and trains.

MMSPNYDB Mk.V v2.67

- "The reason behind the creation of this device is completely unknown to us on the marketing team as well as the CEO, but apparently this product was developed and released to the public for also unknown reasons. Feel free to buy it if you will. Warranty void upon purchase. We have no idea how they made it in one hour, but one hour after they had the idea, they had the box, then they didn't have the box. Ten minutes passed and there it was again."
- The MOC is equally unsure as to why exactly this product was developed and subsequently released for public use. It is utterly useless in functionality and contains an inaccessible interior like most other devices. It is not worth our time. The device appears to be a small box with a red button on the top. Upon pressing the button, the box disappears. The box reappears in the same place it was pressed after exactly 10 minutes. The title stands for Magic Man Schrodinger-Pandora's Now-You-Don't Box Mk.V Version 2.67." We do not know why. Schrodinger was not involved in its creation. No previous marks or versions of the device were created, either. Mk.V and Version 2.67 appear to be arbitrary numbers.

Paulina Lotte Device

- "Developed by the CEO herself, the Paulina Lotte device is capable of rebuilding a random section of the entire universe's fine structure constant! This manipulation is so slight that the chances of the user deatomizing and ceasing to exist is next to none. Careful use should still be maintained, though. Especially since one of these devices cannot exist in certain universes without recalibration."
- There seem to be countless different versions and models of this device that have existed and still do exist, created over the trillions of years of their existence, but only a small fraction of the total line of products still exists to this day due to misuse, loss, or other events. O attempts have been made to recreate the internal structure, since tampering with the seals on the product void the warranty as well as any content inside the machine, making reverse engineering impossible. However, the MOC occasionally makes use of them in dire situations, e.g. the CONV3N13N7 and D3V1C3 Models, the two most powerful ones to date.

Realitillia

- "Based on theories and conjectures from members all over our organization, finally grouped together by our lovely CEO herself, the Realitillia was developed by our greatest engineers! Not for public use, but rather for the gaining of knowledge of how our Reality works, the Realitillia will help us understand the truth of it all!"
- This product has never been seen outside of scraps of blueprints. The details of this are almost entirely unknown to anyone that we have questioned. From bits of information that we have discovered after years of searching, we have determined this device was meant to weaken the membrane of Reality (It appears that Lotte considered this to be a real thing, although it is currently unknown whether Reality has a boundary or not. It is presumed that there is not one, since it has not been observed in any dimensional analyses or otherwise, as reported by all concepts and other entities known by the MOC.) It is assumed to have been unsuccessful, as universal stabilities throughout Reality did not move from the expected, and the structure of Reality overall appeared unaffected. This was most likely for the best.

KnowledgeBox 3000

- "Yet another product created by our wonderful CEO, the KnowledgeBox is capable of teaching the user countless secrets known by anyone in existence! Testing is still incomplete, due to the pulling in of information outside of Reality. Rumor has it that the product will be released within 3 weeks after testing is complete!"
- Only one of these machines has ever been produced, to the knowledge of the MOC, and subsequently lost forever upon their second test. The second test occurred roughly 2 years before the company completely dissolved. The first test was directly responsible for the Sector 02 Cascade. The second test of the product caused Incident KB30000. Details are unknown. MOC members presume that this object attempted to create something from nothing. This is generally accepted as possible, but it appears the scales were too high, potentially on the level of introducing new concepts to Reality. Average stability within universes throughout Reality fluctuated slightly more than expected. These lists may be the only mentions of this device that still exist.

ARTICLE THREE - X-Corp

Overview:

X-Corp is a research organization that exists in the Multiverse. It is a conglomerate of multiple organizations similar to it that have repeated between Universes, a common thing and is the same logic behind Eighth Density mergers.

The organization is led by a mostly-human entity known by everyone as "The Administrator." In the eyes of the MOC, his name is "POI-TA." Throughout the history of their organization, they have stuck to their goals of keeping human life safe, convenient, and educated. This objective has changed over time, shifting into "All life" rather than simple "Human life" due to the varying species throughout Reality. (Divisions 3 & 4, the Divisions where X-Corp operates, are predominantly human, with most nonhuman species being either incredibly similar and only occasionally very different.)

They are currently the second most advanced organization in Reality, falling behind the MOC, and in front of most smaller organizations that are of less concern to the MOC. They are currently lightly briefed on some of the duties on the MOC, and the partnership has benefited both organizations. The MOC has already explained to X-Corp that unascended species should be allowed to leave their Universes themselves, without help from outside groups. This is to prevent unnatural assimilation or dependence on another group. We do not know what the X stands for.

Other Information:

The MOC does not carry too much information on X-Corp, ignoring important things that directly affect Universal stability, information they collect that builds on MOC data, and anything they do that affects the MOC directly.

The Administrator is relatively unknown by MOC employees, with only a few Council members having made direct contact with the entity, those two being MOC12-LAW and MOC25-AUT. Their identity has been intentionally obfuscated so as to protect their identity, therefore making it harder to catalog their appearance, personality, and other facts about them. What is known has been collected through recordings of communications. It is known that they have selected U-A271817 as their home Universe, despite this not being their Universe of origin. U-A271817 is not an ascended Universe and POI-TA is therefore barred from significantly advancing the technology of this world so as to preserve the baseline, the most valuable asset of the MOC.

It is known that X-Corp has developed teleportation technology, which allows transport between Universes. It is theorized that some employees or POI-TA themselves are capable of breaching the UMs of some Universes and traveling throughout FSCO space. It is assumed that they already learned to protect themselves with fragments of the UM, obtained naturally from the edges of Universes.

There are an estimated 14 iterations of X-Corp currently part of the conglomerate, with a few more (Below 20) iterations existing outside of Universes but separate from the conglomerate. There are more iterations that can be found in Universes that have not yet ascended.

ARTICLE FOUR - Dangerous Individuals

POI-VN "Visnon"

POI-VN, also known by the terms "Visnon," "The Visnon Entities," or "VN-Class," is one of the most dangerous repeating concepts handled by the MOC. In most cases, the entity is a basic Seventh Density entity that does not leave its own UM but instead causes chaos locally. In these cases, the entity is ignored as a natural phenomenon occurring in many different Universes, primarily in Divisions Three and Four.

The entity and its repeating concepts have no regard for the stability within their Universe and in most cases the stability of the rest of Reality as well. Some have claimed that VN-Class entities are simply manifestations of chaos, just as many MOC members were manifestations of their specific concepts before undergoing mergers.

Some VN-Class entities are more dangerous than others, with some especially dangerous ones being contained by the MOC directly to prevent the possibility of many Sector Cascades happening at once. One example is the "most chaotic" iteration, known simply as "Visnon." They are currently contained within "The Sphere," a large spherical containment unit designed for holding concepts at bay. It was designed with the knowledge of both the Lotte Company and the MOC, long ago.

Another instance is less passively dangerous but has the potential to be much more devastating if given the opportunity. Known as "Wishgranter Visnon" and "VN-5," their chaotic reach is limited to the space and loopholes they are given in professional dealings, which can be set up either by written or verbal contract followed by a handshake, a classic form of dealmaking. One primary issue is the near-impossibility of containing them, as physical summoning rituals exist that will, without fail, bring the entity to that location in any Universe. It is worth noting that this entity is particularly more intelligent than any of the other iterations. Solace can be taken in the fact that they operate under something similar to a moral compass, and will defend Universes that are in danger in order to have more people to toy with.

POI-RL "Relicia"

The perpetrator of both U-B271836 Incidents. This Seventh Density entity manifested within U-D400777, from another subdivision in Division Four's Sector G6. The entity has only been spotted once, and has been neutralized, now serving as an example of the types of enemies that the MOC faces in carrying out its duties.

Only one iteration of the iteration exists, and two forms were noted. The first was a large, black, cubic stone with golden engravings across the front. This form has been noted to actively attempt to violate the minds of Low-Density entities and convert them to their cause. Their other form is that of a small blonde girl in a black sundress, equipped with a large scythe. The symbolism of death has been noted by some.

Her exceptional danger has been seen in that she shows utter disregard for the membranes between universes, as she can travel between them without any assistance or hampering of speed. She is also capable of surviving in FSC0 space without experiencing the conceptually-degrading effect of Multiversal space for any amount of time and without any form of following. It should also be noted that she speaks of needing a following to survive and that she nearly died while living in her origin Universe. It is unknown as to why, as all signs point to her being able to survive indefinitely in any location. It should also be noted that she nearly defeated MOC25-AUT in a fight. MOC25-AUT is one of the most capable Seventh Density entities known, on the level of the council members, and therefore POI-RL was as well.

ARTICLE FIVE - Universes of Interest

U-A271817 [04:12:G6:271817::A]

Widely known within the MOC as "The Baseline." U-A271817 is, by far, one of the most stable and self-consistent Universes in MOC care. There are no known incidents involving it, and stability has almost never dropped within its UM. Some conceptual entities complain that entering this Universe is a challenge when compared to other ones.

Due to its special properties and exceptional stability, the MOC has become incredibly restrictive in its care, greatly limiting transportation in and out of it. MOC13-CAU has herself stated that this Universe must be protected at all costs. Though this Universe is marked by its own catastrophes, all of them are naturally-occurring and unrelated to Causality, with this Universe not harboring tachyons.

U-B271836 [04:12:G6:271836::B]

This Universe was relatively unknown and did not warrant much focus until its incident began a few years before this document was written. This incident began when a Seventh Density entity escaped their home Universe and entered the UM of this one. After which, stability began to waver and the Universe was recommended a drop in stability ranking. The incident was marked by a large series of time loops embedded into each other and branching out. This Universe's second incident further built on the issues from the first incident, which devolved enough that the MOC was forced to step in to avoid a cascade event. The incident was resolved quickly enough to prevent a drop in its ranking.

Further documentation relating to this incident and the Universe containing it can be found split up between three different documents. These can be found listed as "AtS," "SHS," and "PD2/MA." They must be listed separately due to their size, as well as the fact that this is only an overview. The incident was resolved by MOC25-AUT before she became a Council member, defeating POI-R and ceasing their existence.

This Universe's pair of incidents has been one of the most divisive ones in the MOC's history, being the source of multiple arguments and the source of multiple changes in policy as dictated by MOC02-AES.

U-B271818 [04:12:G6:271818::B]

A fairly unimportant Universe pending demotion to a C-Series universe due to recent drops in stability to unprecedented levels. Despite having been mostly stable throughout its history, an Alpha-Type repeating time loop has formed, incorporating a small town that is unlisted in any official documents not in the town. It is known that a non-ascended X-Corp occupies this Universe as well, with an unknown official located within, among other people of interest.

The loop repeats once weekly, expanding by roughly 12 feet per iteration. The MOC is currently attempting to repair the time loop, as instability within and around this bubble is beyond expected or acceptable levels, and is very concerning for a simple Alpha-Type loop. To prevent changing too much at once, any officials sent in will do so undercover to collect information before a resolution is attempted. It has been determined that tachyon particles are involved with the loop's creation, despite tachyons not being physically possible in this Universe.

U-D400777 [04:G6:13:400777::D]

This Universe is the origin point of the Seventh Density entity, POI-R, that traveled to U-B271836 and caused both U-B271836 Incidents. It has been relatively dead for many billions of years, sitting somewhere around CY-89,461,883. Nearly all remaining stars in this Universe are red dwarfs, leaving the galaxies mostly red. Earth exists in this Universe, surviving a Solar supernova, but no trace remains of humanity or its creations.

It is assumed that POI-R had remained in this Universe for many billions of years before they were able to breach their UM. It is theorized that they were waiting for stability within the Universe to drop enough to allow their leaving. After this, they traveled in a beeline towards a nearby Universe to gain more anchors for their concept. Not much else is known about this Universe, as it is fairly standard.

ARTICLE SIX - Non-Partnered Organizations

Extraneous Takalistinian Commonwealth:

A union between two similar Universes working together to benefit each other. They have yet to make contact with the MOC or other large multiversal organizations so far. It would appear that their observational range is limited, and the universes they inhabit are not inhabited by concepts or many of the repeating elements between most other universes.

Despite their differences, there are still many repeating elements that appear in both of these Universes. For example, the Milky way and the Sol system are almost identical within the Universes. However, their calendar year is roughly 17 years behind the baseline, and their technological standing is nearly 10 years ahead.

The difference between the two Universes is that the leading governmental body is different, as histories have played out differently between the two. The Commonwealth is currently intent on finding more people like them and improving the lives of their citizens. The government is run under a free market system with many freedoms, mirroring the baseline's United States. Although interacting with this government body would result in protections gained for one side, nothing new would be brought to the table for the MOC, so a partnership would likely not arise like it has X-Corp and the Lotte Company.
